EYFS	
Literacy – Book of the week – Peace at Last by Jill Murphy/The Great Big Book of Families Maths (Reception) – Just Like Me – Comparing Maths (Nursery) - Sorting by different attributes Expressive Art and Design (EAD) - rehearsing and performing our Harvest song at the Harvest festival, making pictures of our families in the same style as ‘Peace at Last’ RE – Harvest For our SCARF lesson this week, Reception children are invited to bring to school a toy or object that is special to them - bring to school for lesson on Tuesday.	
KS1	
Maths: Continuing with reasoning and problem solving with numbers to 20 in Year 1. Continuing with reasoning and problem solving with numbers to 100. English: Continuing History cross-curricular work on Louis Braille – Why do we remember Louis Braille today? What were the most important events in his life and who were the most significant people in his life? In DT this week we are beginning to make our own puppets. In RE we are focusing on how Christians show they are thankful during harvest. In Computing we will be working on creating our own stop motion animation. The children are invited to bring in materials from home that may benefit their stop motion animation for example, cardboard boxes, shoe boxes etc.	
KS2	
Year 3 and 4	Year 5 and 6
English and Maths In English, we will be writing an introduction to our own Iron Man story using all the skills we have learnt over the previous lessons. In Maths, we will be looking at rounding to 10s, 100s and 1000s.	In English, we will be learning about direct and indirect speech and evaluating instructions and explanations. In Maths, we will begin our work on Fractions by ordering them and working out fractions of amounts.
