**KS1**

Phonics: Year 1 – ay and oy, Year 2 – I spelt el as in tinsel.

English: KS1 Poetry text ‘Wish You Were Here and I Wasn’t’, investigating poems.

Maths: Year 1 – Telling the time to the hour and half hour, Year 2 – reading the time on digital/analogue clocks to the nearest half hour and nearest quarter hour.
