Change of arrangement for EYFS drop off and collection.

Children will stay inside the classroom and be called to the door when staff have seen the adult/s who is/are collecting your child.



New technology:

We have been fortunate enough over the last few weeks to invest in a set of chromebooks. The chromebooks will provide the whole school with Computing lessons where they now have a device each rather than having to share. They also mean that there is a class set of chromebooks for the children to use in other lessons to support learning in different subjects. EYFS will also have access to two of the chromebooks in their continuous provision to develop their knowledge of technology and computers. We also have a set of 10 iPads already in school which help support our ICT provision.

Trim Trail:

I am delighted to tell you that we have been successful in our bid for the Awards for All Lottery Grant. We now await the arrival of the money to be able to begin the install of our trim trail on the field.

Image Musical Theatre:

After half term we will be welcoming the performance of 'The Sword and the Stone' by Image Musical Theatre.
